A BRIEF GUIDE TO SPARKLING WINES

Sparkling wine was an accidental creation that occurred when unfermented yeast, sealed inside a bottle of wine, began an additional fermentation leading to the production of carbon dioxide that was then trapped in the bottle, producing bubbles. While not actually discovered by *Dom Perignon*, the Benedictine monk was central in the development of the technique that is now known as the *Méthod Champenois* or Traditional Method. Sparkling wines are generally produced by either the Traditional Method, or by the “Tank Method” which is used most expertly in Prosecco.

The Traditional Method:

1. Make a delicious still wine (traditionally using Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and/or Pinot Meunier grapes).
2. Add a mixture of sugar, yeast, and reserved wine to the bottle (*liqueur de tirage*).
3. A second fermentation begins inside the bottle, releasing CO₂ that cannot escape, thus carbonating the wine.
4. Over a period of months or even years, rotate the bottles to a near vertical position, moving the trapped yeast into the neck of the bottle. This is called '*sur-lie*' ('on the lees') aging. *High-end champagnes can enjoy as many as 7+ years of aging in this manner before release!*
5. Quickly freeze the neck of the bottle, allowing it to be broken off, expelling the remaining yeast (*disgorgement*).
6. *Dosage*: A small mixture of still wine with whatever amount of desired sugar (*liqueur d'expédition*) is added to the bottle, sealed with a cork, and set aside or prepare for sale and consumption.

Champagne Aging Rules:

Non-Vintage (NV) Champagne: minimum 15 months on lees in bottle

Vintage Champagne: minimum 3 years on lees in bottle

Most NV Champagne from high-end producers age at least 3 years on lees while vintage and 'tête de cuvée' bottlings often age as long as 7-10 years.

All wines labeled as 'Champagne' must come from the **Champagne Region** of France. Spanish wines from **Cava DO** and Italian wines from the **Franciacorta DOCG** are all made using the 'Traditional Method' (as are most premium sparkling wines around the world), but are often made using different grapes than the traditional 'Champagne' grapes.

Blanc de Blancs: Sparkling wine made using only white grapes (normally Chardonnay)

Blanc de Noirs: Sparkling wine made using only red grapes (normally Pinot Noir / Pinot Meunier).

What is 'Grower Champagne'?

The wines of Champagne are dominated by what are known as the *Maisons* ('houses')—domains such as Moët et Chandon, Veuve Clicquot, Krug, Taittinger, Ruinart, and many others. These producers contract with growers/farmers throughout the Champagne region, buying their grapes, and then producing their prized Champagnes at their large cellars in the cities of Épernay, Ay, or Reims. The end result has been that Champagne is often thought of more as a luxury product produced by brands rather than as fine wine. In the late 20th Century, a few growers decided to stop selling their precious grapes and develop their own brands with Champagnes coming entirely from their own vineyards. This trend, guided by the great Anselme Sélosse, has led to an incredible growth in diversity and individuality in the wines of Champagne. While the Champagnes from the large houses are not inferior and many remain truly delicious wines, the Grower Champagne movement has led the world to finally begin appreciating Champagne as a wine rather than as a product to mindlessly sip at parties. Producers of Grower Champagne regularly make unique wines that might be 100% varietal (Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and even Pinot Meunier), could be aged or fermented in barrel, and are often representing single vineyard crus.

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MAKING PINK WINES

There are few things better on a warm summer day than a crisp, lightly-chilled rosé. Rosé is produced all over the world, with the most important and profound versions traditionally coming from Provence or the Rhône Valley regions of France. Most commonly, rosé is made using red grapes but only allowing the skins to set in the juice for a brief period of time, rather than macerating, fermenting, and aging with the juice. The shorter the skin contact, the lighter the color. Rosé can be made from any red grapes, typically using the primary grapes of a region. Other methods for rosé production include the *saignée* method or blending of some red wine into a white wine. The *saignée* method is unique and produces some very special wines. *Saignée* means 'to bleed' and the concept is to 'bleed' the juice out of the berries. Berries are placed into vats for 2 hours to 2 days like a red wine, but a portion of the juice is released or bled from the tank prior to fermentation. This results in deeper, more concentrated rosé wines that often have a color coming close to a light Pinot Noir.

As a concert pianist, I have enjoyed the remarkable opportunity to travel and explore the world. My love for food and wine began as a 19 year old when I took my first trip to France for concerts in the Loire Valley. I was treated to incredible food and wine, and experienced the central place that these delights had in the daily lives of my hosts. I was picked up at the airport by a jolly Frenchman named Claude in a vintage WWII American Army Jeep and taken immediately to lunch which included bottle of Loire Valley Rosé! While living in New York, I had my first tastes of fine dining and began buying and tasting wines that had life and character, starting primarily with the wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape from France's Rhône Valley. By the time I started my doctoral degree, I was fully committed to studying, experiencing, and tasting wines from around the world, and started a small but enjoyable cellar, buying wines at auction and beginning to understand the intricacies of the winemaking process. In 2006, my wife and I made our first trip to Italy, tasting wines from Montalcino, Super Tuscans from around Tuscany, and incredible Syrah from Cortona. I was hooked. The wines of Italy became my passion and I began an exploration that continues today. We got engaged on a trip to Napa in 2008, and our mutual exploration of the wine world has never stopped!

In 2010, I founded a contemporary music festival in Cortona, Italy, and began leading groups of musicians (up to 40 people) on tastings at some of the finest wineries in Tuscany. During these annual adventures, my wife and I would enjoy vacation time following our festival, and began visiting dozens of wineries and regions around Europe, making lifelong friends and experiencing many incredible encounters with amazing winemakers and chefs.

In 2019, I founded Uncorked Pianist, LLC as a new venture to share my passion for wine and food with others through tastings, tours, personal cellar management, and other wine-related events. This led to my completion of certifications and exams in 2021 from the Court of Master Sommeliers (Certified Sommelier), Wine & Spirits Education Trust (Level 3 Award in Wine), and Society of Wine Educators (Certified Specialist in Wine), and the development of the East Lawrence Wine Academy & Tasting Room, now known as Pane e Vino.

Pane e Vino is where I hope to recreate many of the experiences I have had in Italy, where I have been invited into the homes of winemakers and shared glasses and stories about their culture, history, and the deep passion they have for their work. As a work/live space, you will be entering our living room and enjoying wines, cheeses, and charcuteries all curated from my own experiences. Weekly classes discussing wine regions, individual grape varieties, and the winemaking process will be features of our programming, while the Tasting Room will be open for regular service on the weekends, and free concerts of classical music will be offered each month.
